Our mission is to build hope and healthy families through a helping hand program of structured housing. Allow families with children to remain together in a safe and decent living environment so that they may grow strong, become selfreliant, transform their lives, and crush the cycle of homelessness and poverty.

Our Housing Programs

With over 30 family units (and growing) that we maintain and rent to families in need, it is your help that enables us to provide stability when families need it most.

Additionally we provide case management, rapid rehousing, and other referrals as appropriate to support each family.

Transitional Housing

A two-year program that is income based and focused on helping families move from shelters, motels, and other short term situations into a position to gain long term stabilization.

Permanent Supportive Housing

A longer-termed program that focuses on families that have a fixed income or do not meet the guidelines for transitional housing. Many families will move on from the Transitional Program to the Permanent Supportive Program as they gain financial independence and grow.

Safe Overnight Stay (SOS) Program

Designed for families facing homelessness for the first time and referred to us by Brevard 211, the SOS program is an extremely short term housing solution with highly targeted case management. It seeks to minimize the trauma to the family by working with community resources to help each family create a concrete set of "next steps" over the course of two weeks.
